- When calculating GPA, we will apply courses that both fulfill the appropriate requirements and positively impact the GPA. In certain cases, course substitutions may be made to enhance the GPA. For example, any core mathematics course — excluding college algebra — may be substituted for statistics when beneficial to the nursing science GPA. This flexibility is offered in instances where the nursing science GPA falls below the required threshold.
