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Biography

Kim Belcik, PhD, MSN, RN, CNE, FNP-BC, is a Clinical Associate Professor in the College of Nursing at Texas A&M University, where she joined the faculty in 2024. She teaches across undergraduate and graduate curricula, including community health, adult nursing, and primary care of families, and previously served as Family Nurse Practitioner Program Coordinator for the graduate program, with responsibility for curriculum oversight, accreditation activities, outreach, and approval of preceptors and clinical sites.

Dr. Belcik’s scholarship focuses on creating cultures of scholarly caring in schools of nursing, re-envisioning faculty–student relationships and advancing health policy advocacy. She has co-authored peer-reviewed articles and national teaching tools in areas such as health policy advocacy and population health and has presented her work at national organizations including the National League for Nursing and the International Nursing Association for Clinical Simulation and Learning.

A family nurse practitioner, Dr. Belcik provides primary care for medically underserved populations in Texas and serves in seasonal camp health roles. She is an engaged member of state and national nursing organizations, including the Texas Nurses Association and Texas Nurse Practitioners, where she contributes to policy and advocacy efforts that impact the health and well-being of Texans.
