Biography

Dr. LeRoy A. Marklund is a 30½-year career U.S. Army Nurse Corps Veteran and Clinical Assistant Professor at Texas A&M University (TAMU) College of Nursing. In May 2020, he took a six-month leave of absence when he was recalled out of military retirement and served on active duty as a critical care nurse and Director of the Clinical Nurse Transition Program at Landstuhl Regional Medical Center, Germany, in support of the COVID-19 pandemic. Dr. Marklund graduated in December 2015 with a Doctor in Nursing Practice from the University of Alabama at Birmingham. His academic interests include global health, military healthcare, rural health, disaster preparedness, trauma resuscitation, emerging infectious diseases, and team building. Since July 2018, he has taught undergraduate nursing courses until accepting his current position in August 2025 as the Assistant Dean for Undergraduate Nursing Education and Clinical Associate Professor at the Texas A&M University Higher Education Center at McAllen College of Nursing. He serves as President and Counselor for Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing, Phi Iota Chapter, and is a faculty advisor for several nursing student organizations. Additionally, he serves as committee member for the TAMU Troops to College, Honor Council, and International Operations Committee.
