**Biography**

Nancy Fahrenwald is an accomplished scholar and executive leader. She was recruited as the second College of Nursing dean (June, 2018-August, 2022) and granted tenure as a professor in 2019. In 2022 she was named the inaugural associate vice president for University Health Services (UHS) within A&M Health. She holds a PhD, MS, and BS in Nursing and is engaged and committed to the university's tripartite mission of teaching, scholarship, and service. Her research and evidence-based improvements in access to health care are highly regarded. As a leader with experience on national boards, her tenure at Texas A&M employs collaborative leadership skills to achieve strategic outcomes. During her time as dean, the College of Nursing experienced transformational changes in education programs and research infrastructure that set the stage for distinction as a reputable academic and tier-one research institution. When invited to establish UHS, she focused on creating a high impact health service organization that provides holistic care to over 75,000 students. The vision is for UHS to be a recognized as a leader in university health care through innovation, transformation, and impact. Improvements in access to care and new partnerships with academic, service, and research collaborators are flourishing.
