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Biography

Rosaleen D. Bloom earned her PhD from the University of Utah in cancer nursing in 2017. Dr. Bloom joined Texas A&M University in the Fall of 2022. Her research is focused on supporting cancer patients and their caregivers across the cancer continuum by focusing on cancer prevention and control. She has served as PI, co-Principal Investigator (PI), and co-Investigator on university-, county- and organizational-funded grants. Her previously funded research has been focused on primary prevention by building healthy communities to prevent cancer and other chronic illnesses with underserved populations. This included providing health screening, education, and exercise programs. Other funded research has focused on secondary prevention by understanding and improving cancer screening behaviors. Additional funded research has focused on tertiary prevention (cancer control). This research has focused on supporting individuals and their caregivers during cancer treatment by identifying psychosocial and physical issues and developing potential interventions to address them. Dr. Bloom is also an award-winning teacher, having been recognized at the college and university level for her teaching. She continuously provides service to the college, community, and profession through her various volunteer and leadership positions.
